The Program

The Spirit of Clarkdale Awards Program provides a way for the Clarkdale Town Council to recognize Clarkdale home and business owners, residents and other individuals that have taken steps in the community that are worthy of recognition. Awards are made by the council from nominations that have been reviewed by the Spirit of Clarkdale Review Committee. Anyone may nominate Clarkdale property owners or business owner or other individuals or citizens they feel deserve recognition for projects or actions that enhance the “Spirit of Clarkdale”.

Award Categories

- Property Beautification
- Historical Preservation
- Neighborhood Programs/Events/Projects
- Community Volunteerism

Eligibility Requirements

Town of Clarkdale residents, neighborhood or other groups, businesses and/or other individuals who have undertaken a project, program, or activity that creates an overall positive impact on the Spirit of Clarkdale are eligible to be nominated for the Award.

Nomination Submission and Selection Process

Complete the nomination form. Include supporting materials as specified for particular award category (i.e. photos (before and after), flyers, letters of support, testimonials, etc.) and submit them to:

Award Criteria

Property Beautification

All nominations must demonstrate that an effort was made to beautify the property. Projects would be considered using one or more of the following criteria:

- **Architectural Merit** - The architecture and design is visually compatible with the buildings, structures and places in the immediate vicinity.
- **Material, Texture and Color** – Demonstrates use of materials, textures and colors that are visually compatible with the immediate vicinity.
- **Architectural Details** - Doors, windows, eaves, cornices and other architectural details of a building or structure are visually compatible with buildings and structures to which they are related.
- **Landscaping** - Landscaping is aesthetically pleasing and focuses on low water use and drought tolerant vegetation, as recommended on the Town's Native Vegetation list.
- **Lighting** - Any on-site illumination is architecturally compatible to the overall project, meets the Town's lighting regulations, and does not create a negative or visually detrimental effect on the building or neighboring properties.
- **Improved Aesthetics** – The general nature of the project improves the aesthetics of the project site, and/or the neighborhood or area in general.

Historical Preservation

All nominations must demonstrate that an effort was made to retain or enhance the historical preservation of the property. Projects would be considered using one or more of the following criteria:

- Did the project preserve historic cultural or resources?
- Did the project protect and preserve archaeological resources of significance?
- Does the project encourage historical preservation?
- Did the project preserve, restore and/or rehabilitate historic architectural resources?
- Did the project revitalize a historic center/neighborhood?
- Was the property in danger of being demolished?
- Did the property ever play a documented role in the history of the town?

Applicants should attach before and after photos of the project with this application.

Neighborhood Programs/Events/Projects

All nominations must demonstrate that an effort was made to retain or enhance the neighborhood by involvement. Projects would be considered using one or more of the following criteria:

- Residents working together as volunteers to improve the visual and physical environment of the community.
- Encouraging individual and community responsibility for neighborhood beautification.
- An increased awareness of the importance of enhancing the quality of life in Town of Clarkdale through Neighborhood programs, events or projects.
- Neighborhood unity was promoted
- Significant impact was made on neighborhood communication, interaction and cooperation.

Community Volunteerism

All nominations must demonstrate that an effort was made to ... Nomination would be considered using one or more of the following criteria:

- Exceptional service contribution to the Town
- Improve the quality of life in the Town of Clarkdale.
