# CONCERTS IN THE PARK

The concerts' attendance have increased and have always been highly supported by the community allowing for the concerts to be brought back year after year. Many residents look forward to the concerts: some pack a picnic dinner and eat under the starry night, while others lay a blanket down for an evening to relax and listen to the music allowing the children to enjoy the kids' play area. Every concert will bring an evening of great entertainment, whether you choose to just sit and listen or like to dance the night away!

This year's series includes seven concerts throughout the summer months offering a wide variety of genres.

## Put on Your Dancing Shoes!

In addition to listening to the wonderful music throughout the evening dancing is greatly encouraged! If you should get the feeling of happy feet there is a large concrete dance floor with plenty of space for dancing. We ask that if you have

children who love to showcase their dance moves that you and your children are courteous to the others on the dance floor. It is easy for an adult to be dancing and not be aware of small ones underneath which can result in a not so wonderful situation. We appreciate your courteousness!

## PARK RULES

### The following is prohibited in the park:

1. Any violation of state law or Town Ordinance, including but not limited to disorderly conduct, criminal damage and applicable animal control regulations.
2. The consumption of intoxicating beverages.
3. Vehicles on any portion of the park.
4. Conducting organized gatherings (i.e. arts/crafts shows) in which the number of displays exceeds fifty (50), without a permit from Town of Clarkdale.
5. The placement of any permanent structure, unless authorized by the Town of Clarkdale.
6. Vandalism or destruction of park property.
7. Camping within the park.
8. Dog owners or handlers shall clean up all litter created by the animal. Owners of seeing eye dogs are exempted.
9. Any activity which begins prior to 6:00 a.m. or continues past 9:00 p.m.



## Love 'Em and Leash 'Em!

Dogs are always welcome in the Clarkdale Town Park. Please be aware that Clarkdale Town Code, Section 6-3-1, requires that your dog be on a leash, which is not to exceed 6 feet long, and must be under your complete control. This law will be enforced by the Clarkdale Police Department so please make sure that you are in compliance or you may be cited.



It takes a cooperative effort to make the park safe and comfortable for everyone in attendance so please always be aware of your surroundings and considerate of others. This is for both the safety of your dog and the safety of others attending the concerts.

In addition to the leash law, please follow these simple rules while visiting the Town's park:

- Please respect other park visitors: do not let your dog chase or jump on others, including other dogs.
- Please stay with your dog at all times.
- Please clean up after your dog and dispose of waste in the trash cans located in the park. Mutt Mitts are provided throughout the park.
